# **Stockman Development Scheme**

The Stockman Development Scheme is a combination of pig production workshops, covering each stage of production from service to slaughter, delivered by technical experts. Focusing on basic knowledge and everyday tasks, it is suitable for individuals who are new to the industry or wish to refresh their knowledge.

#### **Course costs**

The full-course cost to levy payers is £210+VAT, which includes all workshops, lunch at each session and course folders. Workshops can be attended on an ad hoc basis at a cost of

£35+VAT per session. The full-course cost is £700; however, all courses and sessions are 70 per cent-subsidised by AHDB Pork.

## Stockman Plus Scheme

Stockman Plus is the next step on from the Stockman Development Scheme; it aims to continue knowledge acquisition and the technical development of pig unit staff.

It is a programme of problem-solving workshops, led by technical experts, designed to build on existing pig husbandry knowledge. The first session also includes a 'virtual tour' hour, where participants can find out about each other's units and job roles.

#### Course costs

The full-course cost to levy payers is **£210+VAT**, which includes all workshops, lunch at each session and course folders.

Workshops can be attended on an ad hoc basis at a cost of £35+VAT per session. The full-course cost is £700; however, all courses and sessions are 70 per cent-subsidised by AHDB Pork.
