**Part 2.** Stephen has written in the press, "It's the individual (bought and paid for) sow and not the collective herd that's the primary unit of cost-related productivity. The two most important figures a producer needs to understand is the average lifetime output/sow and the total herd feed conversion (FCR). Understanding the average lifetime output/sow opens a journey of discovery". He will demonstrate the impact of output per sow on breeding herd performance.
